
WHY IT MATTERS

The State of California is last in the nation in school library funding. This means public school libraries in already-underserved schools all over Los Angeles will continue to be ravaged by years of neglect and a lack of support at every level.

THE IMPACT

Every school library receives as many as 2,000 new hardcover books and another 2,500 for classroom use. Book collections include the classics, popular series and stories written by

diverse writers, including talented authors from Los Angeles. The library is also transformed with new shelves, furniture, a new coat of paint and dozens of brightly colored murals.

A school library book can cost as much as \$35 but our team secures them for a third of the cost ensuring that **88 cents of every** dollar donated goes directly to the purchase of books and special programs.
