

Many children in disadvantaged communities don't have books at home. The public library is too far away or in a dangerous neighborhood. The books in their school library are old and falling apart. Without access to good books, how do we expect these children to become enthusiastic readers and learners?

Please consider revitalizing a school library with Access Books. We work with Title 1 schools where most children live at or below the poverty line. The libraries we serve often have less than 5 books per student (compare this to your typical Westside school where the book to student ratio is 26 to 1).
